Sub: Academic Eligibility for the year 2017-18 for Admission to 1st Sem B.E. /B.Tech / B.Arch. Courses – reg..

It is hereby notified to all the Principals of Engineering Colleges: affiliated / Autonomous / Constituent under VTU that the candidates who have the following credentials shall be eligible for seeking admission to I year B.E. / B.Tech. / B.Arch. courses for the academic year 2017-18.

: ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY:

- a) For admission to B.E./B.Tech. Courses: The student should have passed 2nd PUC / 12th standard or equivalent examination from a recognized board with English as one of the languages and obtained 45% of marks in aggregate in Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry / Bio-Technology / Computer Science / Electronics / Biology. In case of candidates belonging to Karnataka Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and other Backward Classes (Category I, 2A,2B, 3A and 3B), the minimum marks for the purpose of eligibility will be 40% of marks in aggregate in the optional subjects in the qualifying examination.
- b) For Admission to B.Arch.: The student should have passed 2nd PUC /12th standard or equivalent examination from a recognized board with Mathematics as a compulsory optional subject and obtained a minimum of 50% of marks in aggregate in all the subjects in qualifying examination [45% of marks in case a candidates belonging to Karnataka Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe and other Backward Classes (Category I, 2A,2B, 3A and 3B)] and should compulsorily appear for NATA [National Aptitude Test in Architecture] and obtained a minimum of 40% in NATA (including SC, ST and other Backward Classes).
