The academic eligibility the year 2017-18 notified as under:

- 1. The candidates who have the following credentials shall be eligible for seeking admission to I year B.E. / B.Tech. / B.Arch. courses for the academic year 2017-18.
- 2. This shall be applicable to all candidates seeking admission to all colleges under the purview of this University (including Private / Govt./ Aided/ Unaided / Minority / Affiliated/ Autonomous etc.) under both Government and Management quota
- 3. Rounding of total aggregate percentage is not permitted. i.e. Total aggregate percentage is 44.98%/39.99%, it cannot treated as 45%/40% respectively.

3	B.Arch.:	Admission to the first year of the course shall be open to the students; (a) who have passed the two year Pre-University examination conducted by the Karnataka State Pre-University Board with Mathematics as a subject of study; or (b) who have passed 10+2 of the Central Board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E.) or equivalent with Mathematics as a subject of study; or (c) who possess Three-Year Diploma in Architecture or any stream of Engineering recognized by Government of Karnataka, or any other State govt. or Central government or any other Diploma qualification considered equivalent there to by this University; (d) who possess international Baccalaureate Diploma, after 10 years of Schooling; or (e) Who have passed any other examination recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.
		The candidates shall have secured a minimum of 50% of marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination. Provided that candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and any other groups classified by the Government of Karnataka for such purpose from time to time shall be considered eligible for admission, if they have passed the qualifying examination giving eligibility for B.Arch. admission with 45% of marks in aggregate.

		All the candidates seeking admission to B.Arch. shall pass the NATA (National Aptitude Test in Architecture) conducted by the Council of Architecture, New Delhi. Qualification in NATA is subject to the candidate getting at least cut-off marks in the two individual components and also getting at least the qualifying marks in aggregate. This requirement is to be fulfilled by all candidates including those belonging to Scheduled Castes, scheduled tribes and other classified groups. Those students, who have passed a qualifying examination other than the PUC II examination of the Pre-University Education Board of Karnataka, have to obtain eligibility certificate for seeking admission to B.Arch. Degree Programme from Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi.

In case of any doubt or ambiguity, the Principals are requested to refer the individual case to the University for Clarification. It is also brought to the notice of the Principals that in case of improper admission, the Principal is wholly responsible and provisional admission made shall be withdrawn by the University. Therefore, the Principals are advised to take utmost care while admitting candidates to the respective courses, so as to avoid cancellation of admission and litigation later on.
