REPORT ON TS EAMCET-III-2016 CONDUCTED BY JNT UNIVERSITY HYDERABAD (ON BEHALF OF TSCHE, HYDERABAD)

The Telangana State Council of Higher Education has assigned the task of conducting TS EAMCET-III-2016 to the Jawaharlal Nehru Technological University Hyderabad vide Procgs. No. TSCHE/CETs/CMP/TS EAMCET-III-2016/Sep. dt. 02-08-2016.

The notification for TS EAMCET-III-2016 was released on 8th August, 2016. The Details of the TS EAMCET-III-2016 schedule is given in Annexure-I.

A total of **56,153** candidates registered for the TS EAMCET-II-2016 examination and the same number of candidates are permitted to appear for TS EAMCET-III-2016. A total of **14** Regional Centres were identified. The list of Regional Centres is given in Annexure-II. The examination was conducted on **11-09-2016** from **10.00 A.M. to 1.00 P.M.** The Set Code **'S2'** was selected by **Prof.T.Papi Reddy, Chairman, TSCHE.**

The total number of Test Centres in various regions were **96**. The Test Centres have been identified in State and Central Government Institutions / Organizations. The Regional Centre wise number of Test Centres list is given in Annexure-III.

The details of number of candidates Registered, Present and Absent Regional Centre wise are given in Annexure-IV and overall percentage of attendance for the test is **66.21**. The Question Paper consists of 160 multiple choice questions. Utmost care was taken to prevent malpractice cases including

impersonation by providing candidate specific OMRs and Nominal Rolls with photograph, Name and Date of Birth.

The biometric finger prints along with the photograph of all the candidates have been taken in the examination halls for verification of genuiness of the candidates and to avoid impersonation.

A total of **2,340** Invigilators, **124** observers, **25** Special Observers for the Regional Centres and **45** Enforcement Officers along with Police and Revenue officials with flying squads are appointed for the smooth conduct of examination and to prevent any malpractices. Revenue, Treasury, Police officials, RTC, TRANSCO and Educational Institutions have extended their cooperation for the smooth conduct of Examination.

Awareness camps have been conducted in all the Regional Centres to apprise the Chief Superintendents, Observers, Enforcement Officers and Special Observers for the smooth conduct of examination.

Remarks on Key

The Preliminary Key Committee was released on 11-09-2016. The Last Date for receiving Objections on Preliminary Key was 14-09-2016 till 4.00 P.M. The Final Key Committee again met and thoroughly reviewed on all the objections received 13-09-2016 and 14-09-2016 from the students, Teachers, Parents, Press & Media.

The following are the Remarks on the Key:

The Committee has thoroughly verified all the objections received from the candidates.

This year again, weightage of 25% marks is given to the marks obtained in Intermediate or Equivalent Exam and 75% weightage for marks obtained in TS EAMCET-III-2016. The criteria for the ranking is presented in Annexure-V. The procedure for calculating the Ranks is presented in Annexure-VI.

Out of **37,180** appeared candidates for the examination, **36,834** candidates got qualified in TS EAMCET-III-2016 & passed in the Qualifying examination and awarded Rank. The percentage of qualified candidates for whom the rank is awarded is **99.07**.

DETAILS OF CANDIDATES REGISTERED CATEGORY WISE

CRITERIA FOR RANKING (TS EAMCET-III-2016)

As per G.O.Ms.No. 165 dated 06-09-2007 and G.O.Ms.No.8 (Amendment to the GO.Ms. No 16) Higher Education Department, dated 27-01-2010, the candidates who have secured qualifying marks in EAMCET and candidates belonging to the category of Scheduled Caste and Schedule Tribe, for whom qualifying marks have not been prescribed, shall be assigned ranking in the order of merit on the basis of combined score obtained by giving 75% weightage to the marks secured in EAMCET and 25% weightage to the marks secured in the relevant group subjects namely Biology, Physics, Chemistry of the qualifying examination.

For the preparation of merit list, in case of more than one student securing the same combined score obtained as mentioned above, the tie shall be resolved to decide the relative ranking by successively considering the following

- i) The total marks secured in EAMCET
- ii) the Marks secured in Biology in EAMCET
- iii) the marks secured in Physics in EAMCET
- iv) the Percentage of Aggregate marks secured in the qualifying examination
- v) if the tie still persists the date of birth of the concerned candidates, the older being given preference over the younger.

The weightage of marks in the case of candidates belonging to the category of Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) / Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) Card Holders, will be decided by a committee constituted by the competent authority.

TS EAMCET-III-2016 PROCEDURE FOR CALCULATING THE RANKS

An example given below shows how we arrive to the combined score and ranking.

C. Weightage calculation & Ranking

- i) For EAMCET with 75% weightage For X candidate : 140/160X75 = 65.625 For Y candidate : 151/160X75 = 70.781
- ii) For qualifying exam with 25% weightage of group marks For X candidate : 560/600X25 = 23.230 For Y candidate : 510/600X25 = 21.250
- iii) Combined Score For X candidate : 65.625+23.230 = 88.955 For Y candidate : 70.781+21.250 = 92.031
- iv) Ranking of the candidate First Rank – to Y candidate Second Rank – to X candidate

D. Criterion for Ranking in case of tie

- I. By taking the total marks in EAMCET into account
- II. By taking the marks secured in Biology subjects in EAMCET into account
- III. By taking the marks secured in Physics in EAMCET into account
- IV. The Grand total % of aggregate marks scored in the qualifying examination. For example if a candidate scores grand total of 850 marks which includes language subjects also out of 1000 then the grand total % of aggregate is 85.
- V. Date of Birth of the candidate, the older being given preference over the younger.
